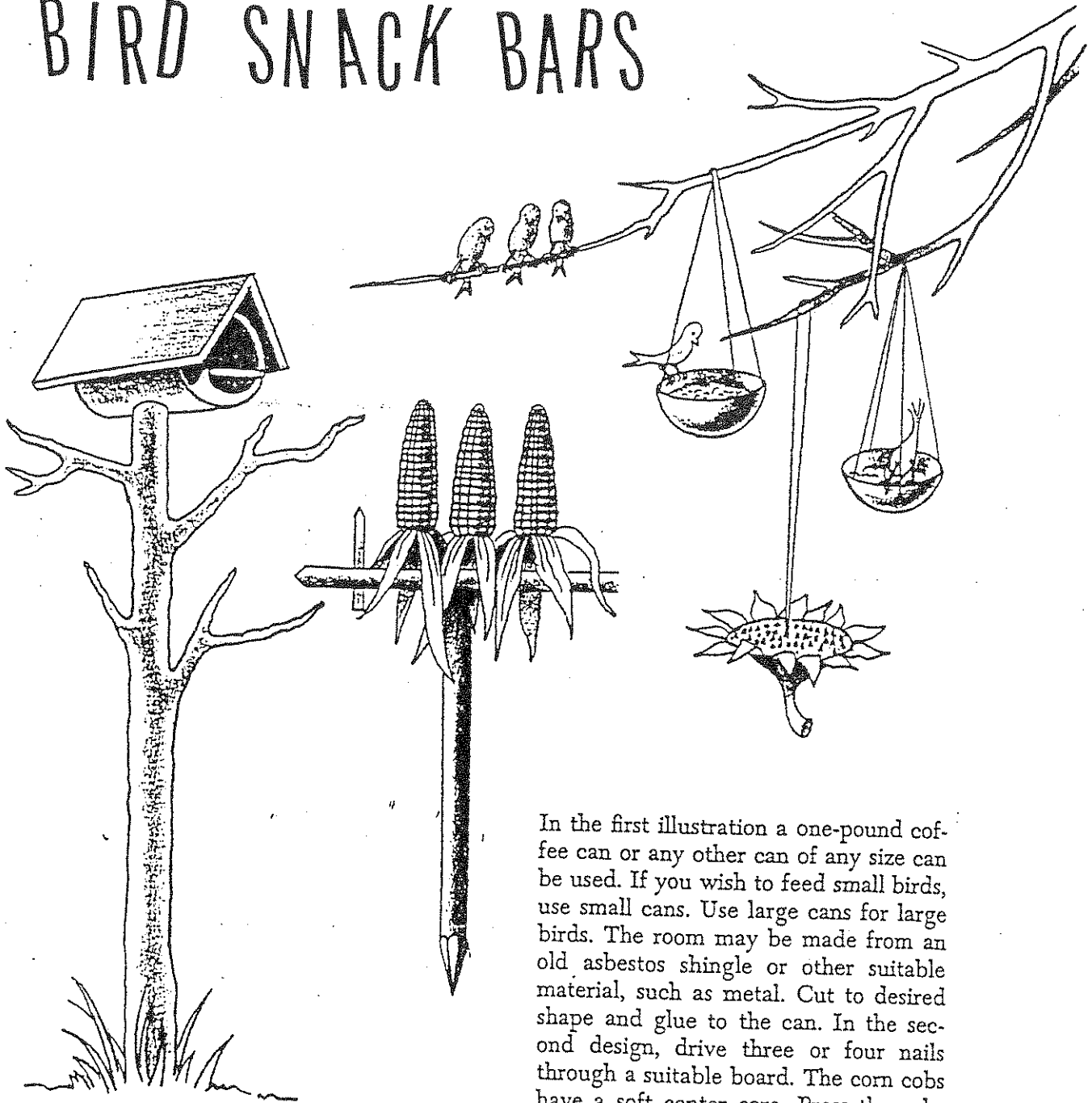


# BIRD SNACK BARS



In the first illustration a one-pound coffee can or any other can of any size can be used. If you wish to feed small birds, use small cans. Use large cans for large birds. The room may be made from an old asbestos shingle or other suitable material, such as metal. Cut to desired shape and glue to the can. In the second design, drive three or four nails through a suitable board. The corn cobs have a soft center core. Press the cobs on to the nails. Nail this board to a stake, and drive it into the ground. The material used in the third illustration may be a gourd or coconut cut in half. Punch or drill equally spaced holes in the halves. Use string or cord to mount the feeder. The fourth suggestion is a ripened sunflower. Use a needle, an ice pick or other sharp instrument to make a hole in the center of the pod. Use string to suspend it from a branch.
