Using those interests to purposely select pieces of equipment and activities is a key to instructional success and student learning. Come and enjoy some fun equipment and activities that engage students with ASD in play and physical activity. The focus of this session will be on unique equipment/innovations that encourage play and interaction.

...great equipment for engaging students with autism in physical education activities

Medicine balls: HEAVY balls...use for tossing and catching, rolling, and kicking

Exercise balls: fun for bouncing, relaxation, and exercise....also fun for kicking and catching

Pop up cubes and Playhut pop up play structures...fun for hiding and playing
Fun laundry hampers: good place to put things away or HIDE!

Juice bottles with clothespins or small balls inside

Use clear plastic peanut butter jars to hold high interest balls...

Deck tennis rings: Throwing, catching and ring toss
Coop bands: Group exercises, High 5's and scooters


Balloons, garbage bags, flyswatters and paint stirrers: beginning striking
