	 Each group will have 2 to 4 students. The students from the same class will work together to fling stuffed animals to their designated target area. The groups should each get one parachute. Groups will stand in the middle (equal distance to the side walls). Animals should be placed next to the wall on one side of the gym. The designated target area should be on the opposite side of the gym from where the animals are. 	2 parachutes (1 for each group) 16 animals (8 per group) 4 puzzle pieces for
8	 Groups can retrieve on animal at a time, go back to the spot where they can fling and using their parachute they should try to fling the animal in there designated target area. If they miss the target area, they must go get the animal, bring it back to their spot and try again. When a group successfully flings an animal in their target area, they can then retrieve another animal. Groups must hang onto the parachute and run together to retrieve the animals. After the group has flung all their animals into their target area they must work together as a group to do 50 jumping jacks – counting out loud together. The group must work together to complete the matching activity to get permission to open the puzzle box. After all 4 students in the group put their ping pong balls on the towel, all 4 students must complete 50 jumping jacks together counting out loud as a group. Next, all 4 students must work together to complete the matching activity to get permission to open the puzzle box. When the puzzle box is opened, each student must take one puzzle piece and bring it to the designated puzzle piece area for their team. The puzzle piece must be placed face down in a pile (on top of the other puzzle pieces) **students must jog, jump, etc in place while waiting to participate in their stage and after their stage is complete. Next, each student has to run their colored ping pong balls back down to their team's towel and set them up. Students can only run one ping pong ball down at a time. Ping pong balls must line up on the towel so the phrase reads: <u>PJH Titans Rock it!</u> Once the phrase is complete and on the towel, all 4 students in the group must complete 50 jumping jacks together, counting out loud as a group. 
