9. Find a story online, in a magazine, or newspaper that details how someone's life was "short-lived" from tobacco, alcohol, or drug abuse and summarize in your own words **10 points**

1. Create a Tri-Fold pamphlet on tobacco abuse **15 points** or an informative poster on tobacco abuse **10 points**
2. Create a Tri-Fold pamphlet on prescription drug abuse **15points** or an informative poster on prescription drug abuse. **10 points**
3. Create a Jeopardy style game with 3 topics (alcohol, tobacco, drugs) and 5 questions for each topic for a total of 15 questions. (See below)(Create on paper and avoid true/false questions or yes/no.) **25 points**

6. Create a children's book (at least 10 pages) with illustrations that explains the dangers of tobacco, drugs or alcohol. **20 points**
7. Create an Animoto (www.animoto.com) on drugs, alcohol, or tobacco. **25 points**
8. Create a (www.GoAnimate.com) video on tobacco, drugs, or alcohol **25 point**
9. Create an electronic story on www.storybird.com on alcohol, drugs, or tobacco and present to class for credit. **25 points**

1. Why do you think tobacco advertisements target teens? Explain why or why not? **50 points**
2. In your opinion, do you think the tobacco companies are responsible for the deaths caused by tobacco use? **50points**
3. In your opinion, do you think that a mother should serve a jail sentence for causing "Fetal Alcohol Syndrome" in their newborn baby? Why or why not? **50 points**
4. Do you have the right to tell someone to "butt out" (put their cigarette out?) **50points**
5. Do you think all public facilities (restaurants, malls, parks, etc...) should be 100% tobacco free? Why or Why not? **50 points**
6. In your opinion, should parents be found negligent (*unlawful*) and be punished by law if they have minors (under 21 years of age) drinking at their house? **50 points**
7. Which do you think is worse to abuse: Drugs, Alcohol, or Tobacco? **Defend your answer. 50 points**
8. In your opinion, should alcoholism be treated as a disease? **50 points**
9. In your opinion, does media(movies, television shows) help promote or prevent underage substance abuse? **50 points**
10. In your opinion, should an athlete's records or awards be erased because of the use of sports enhancing drugs? **50 points**
